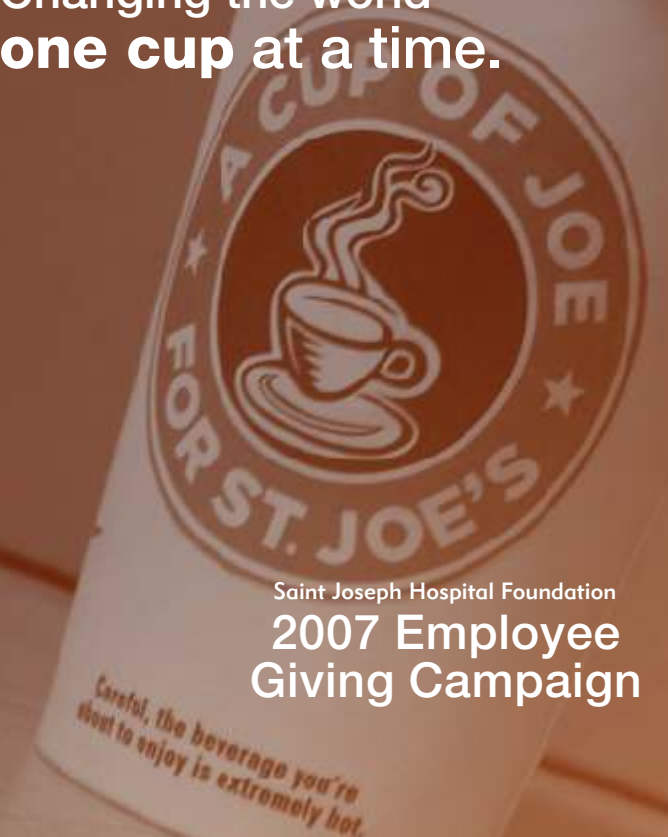
In 2004, nearly \$1.3 million was provided in support of charity and general indigent medical care programs, community health programs, medical education, capital projects, equipment needs and nursing education.

Employee Education Funds

CPMG Healthcare Education Fund – 2443

A seed grant from the Colorado Permanente Medical Group (CPMG), in cooperation with Exempla, created the special fund to improve the future of health care delivery at SJH. The fund supports professionals entering health care, addressing shortages in acute care settings. Scholarships for nurse and allied health positions are priorities.

Sister Mary Andrew Endowment for Excellence – 2320

Supports Saint Joseph Hospital's commitment to excellence in patient care and enhances the Hospital's continuing ability to fulfill its mission. In addition, a portion of earning each year is to be devoted to education grants for children of employees at Saint Joseph Hospital.

Cardiovascular Education Fund – 2460

For education of cardiovascular staff members and physicians.

Continuing Medical Education Fund – 2640

The general advancement of Continuing Medical Education at Saint Joseph Hospital.

Diagnostic Imaging Education/Research Fund – 2410

Continuing education seminars and research.

Internal Medicine Residency Fund – 2557

Provides supplies equipment, education materials, or funding for clinical or basic research for the Internal Medicine Residency.

Maternal/Fetal Education – 2503

Purchases equipment and books for the maternal/fetal medicine (MFM) library, and the education of staff in the department of maternal/fetal medicine.

Non-Physician Education – 2380

Health care education for Saint Joseph Hospital non-physician employees.

OB/GYN Resident Education Fund – 2555

General support for OB/GYN medical education residents.

Pharmacy Education Fund – 2430

Provides support for educational activities for pharmacy personnel and funding for gifts restricted to the general supports of the Saint Joseph Hospital pharmacy.

Radiation/Oncology Education Fund – 2485

Provides funds to be used in the continuing and special education of the radiation/oncology staff.

SurgiCare One PACU – 2355

Equipment and ongoing education for nursing/ancillary staff.

Employee Education Funds – Continued

Lab Tech Education/Research Fund – 2415

To provide additional support for education and research activities for Saint Joseph Hospital lab employees.

PACU Nurse Education Fund – 2435

Established to provide support for educational activities for recovery room nurses and personnel.

Rehabilitation Services Fund – 2585

Supports educational activities of the rehabilitation services personnel.

Intensive Care Unit – 2540

For minor equipment and educational opportunities for the Intensive Care Unit personnel

Community Program Funds

Neonatal Intensive Care Unit – 2350

This restricted fund of the Saint Joseph Hospital Foundation supports capital needs, continuing education for NICU staff and any special needs for the babies or families of the NICU. In addition, contributions to this fund support an annual Reunion Picnic for children who have graduated from the NICU and their families.

Baby's First Ride – 2578

The program offers all parents delivering a baby at Saint Joseph Hospital the opportunity to have their child safety seat inspected by a certified safety seat technician before they leave the Hospital with their newborn infant.

Baby Bootique – 2574

An incentive program to encourage women to seek prenatal care.

Boot Camp for New Dads – 2582

An educational program aimed at educating first time fathers about the life transitions and challenges encountered when becoming a dad.

William V. Gervasini Memorial Library – 2560

Purchases of books to support the operation of the Patient/Community Library, provides funding for gifts restricted to community education programs and medical library.

Charity Care Funds

Employee Humanitarian Fund – 2710

Provides financial assistance to employees of Saint Joseph Hospital in times of emergency and crisis.

Caritas Clinic Fund (Charity Care) – 2510

Provides funding for gifts restricted to support charity care.

Senior Healthcare Fund – 2565

Broad spectrum of support for senior medical care needs.

Sister Marianna Bauder World Mission Fund for the Poor (Mission Services) – 2675

Provides medical care and services to the poor in third world countries. Donations are used for medical equipment and supplies, provision of needed services, and when necessary to pay for transportation of goods.

Family Practice Fund – 2525

Support of charity care through the Family Practice Center, and the Saint Joseph Hospital Family Practice Residency Program.

Breast Cancer Fund – 2507

Provides medical treatment for women who may not have access to health care due to insurance reasons.

Cancer Fund – 2505

General cancer related purposes.

Cardiac Care Fund – 2610

Provides funding for gifts restricted to the Cardiovascular Laboratory.

Saint Christopher House – 2816

Assistance for emergency housing needs for patients and/or families of patients.

Women's Pavilion Fund – 2570

Education for women related health issues.

Capital Projects

Cardiovascular Lab Expansion – 2665

The Saint Joseph Hospital Foundation is providing funding for the cardiovascular lab replacement project.
